Requirements for Academic Internship at Rwanda Governance Board (RGB)

The Rwanda Governance Board (RGB) hereby informs students wishing to undertake an academic internship at the institution that applications are received in accordance with the criteria outlined below.

Eligibility and Application Requirements

1. Application Documents

Applicants must submit the following documents:

- An official letter from their academic institution confirming that the internship is a mandatory requirement of their academic program;
- An application letter addressed to the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Rwanda Governance Board;
- A copy of the National Identity Card (Indangamuntu).

2. Internship Details

The application letter must clearly specify:

- The department or field of interest;
- The proposed duration of the internship;
- The current year of study at the time of application.

3. Commitment to Institutional Rules and Professional Conduct

Applicants must commit to respecting and adhering to RGB's rules, regulations, professional standards, and work ethics throughout the internship period.
