# RGB PUBLISHES THE 11TH EDITION OF THE RWANDA GOVERNANCE SCORECARD (RGS)

Rwanda Governance Board (RGB) publishes the 11th edition of the Rwanda Governance Scorecard (RGS), in which Safety and Security remains the highest-performing pillar with a score of 93.82%.

Like in the previous editions, this year's scorecard assesses the state of governance based on eight pillars namely:

- 1 Rule of Law
- 2 Political Rights and Civil Liberties
- 3 Participation and Inclusiveness
- 4 Safety and Security
- 5 Investing in Human and Social Development
- 6 Anti-corruption, Transparency, and Accountability
- 7 Quality of Service Delivery
- 8 Economic and Corporate Governance.
